The garden slowly builds through the season from rhododendrons and snakeshead fritillaries to a crescendo of bright reds, yellows, oranges, and strong blues and purples in August and September. Perfumes, songbirds and nests are everywhere. Large displays of crocosmia and pulmonarias and the national collection of helenium. Picnics in the garden are welcome, WC in garden.
